Rules & Regulations

Competition held on Saturday, Feb. 19

- Registration for the chili cook-off contest will available at parks.sbcounty.gov/calico-california-days beginning on Saturday, Feb. 12, 2022 until space is filled. Space is limited to 10 contestants.
- Cooking area opens at 9 a.m. and all cooking must be completed by 2:45 p.m. Judges tasting will begin promptly at 3 p.m.
- No food may be prepared at home. This includes, but is not limited to slicing, seasoning, and marinating. All food must be prepared at your station.
- All food ingredients must be obtained from an approved source. A list of this source (or receipt) must be available the day of the competition.
- All food shall be prepared and served in an approved manner to prevent contamination. Food must be prepared at the event. Each competitor is expected to bring all cooking equipment, grill, etc.
- Competitor must bring enough utensils and cutting boards so that if anything drops or is unclean, it can be replaced with new, clean equipment.
- Potentially Hazardous Food (PHF) must be cooked and maintained at proper temperatures. PHFs for hot holding shall be maintained at 135°F or above. PHFs for cold holding shall be maintained at 41°F or below.
- Sampling portions must be 2 ounces or less. Judges' samples must be protected from potential contamination. Samples will be distributed by directly handing samples to judges.
- During the cooking process, containers of food shall be protected from potential contamination by means of lids and/or overhead protection.
