- Calico Jail** - Home of the infamous Calico Gunfighters and Marshal Bismarck Bob.

Silver jewelry as well as turquoise and coral Navajo made silver. Calico Rocks & Fossils. Trilobites, fish fossils and mosasaurus skulls. Geode cracking.

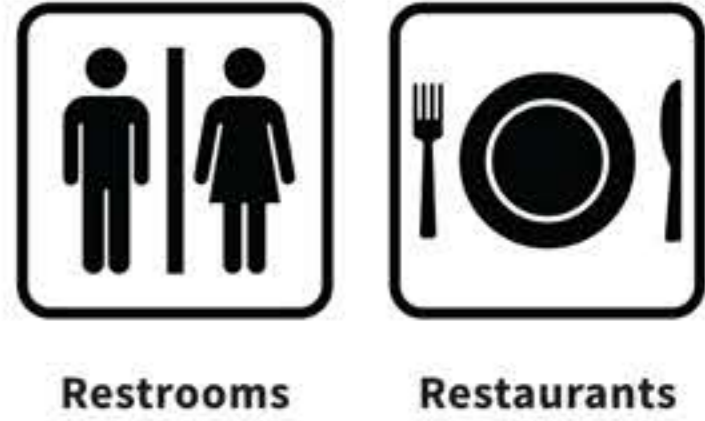
