California Department of Fish and Wildlife:

Chanelle Davis stated hunt information can be found on their website. Cubs were hit by vehicles near Oak Glen and Forest Falls. A poaching case, believed to be from San Bernardino County and a bear death from Mountain Home Village are being investigated. The Human Wildlife Conflict Specialist is focusing on wildlife complaints. Chanelle Davis explained the importance of accuracy of bear and deer validation.

She expressed her desire to host a hunt for the Fish and Wildlife Commission on either State or County property. The Commission stated they would like to plan a hunt for 2023.

Grand Funding Request from The California Wild Sheep Foundation

This request will be presented to the Board of Supervisors on October 4, 2022. There are sheep signs on Highway 38 and Fish and Wildlife is spreading frozen mountain lion feces to deter sheep from public places.

Ms. Stevenson discussed the Fish and Wildlife Festival subcommittee meetings. Commissioner Halbrook invited the guests to participate in the festival and they agreed.
