Fish and Wildlife:

<u>California Department of</u> Warden Garcia asked the Commission for clarification on the information they would like for him to provide. Commissioner Franklin suggested staffing, budget, priorities and/or special projects. Commissioner Olin suggested information on major arrests and Commission Cox suggested fine and violation information. Warden Garcia stated he can track statistics as well. He explained an incident to the Commission involving a deer decoy in Apple Valley.

> Chanelle Davis went over the completed pheasant hunts. There was a good turnout for the family hunt. No person nor dog was injured during any of the events, and they are planning on doing it again next season. She will inform the Commission of the dates when they are determined. She stated the bears in the Yucaipa area are still causing issues as well as the coyotes throughout San Bernardino County. She roughly explained San Bernardino County's process with handling covotes and suggested all residents to call Animal Control if they are having coyote issues.

2023 Fish and Wildlife Festival

Commissioner Fresonke updated the Commission regarding the pending possible sponsorship with Bass Pro Shop. The sponsorship request was lowered from \$25,000 to \$10,000. Mrs. Davis explained that the Grant for this would go through FOR Parks and not San Bernardino County. Commissioner Fresonke requested that each Commissioner try and obtain sponsorships.

Ms. Stevenson supplied the Commissioners with a sponsorship packet for their approval. Commissioner Blocker made a motion to submit the sponsorship packet as presented to the Commission by Ms. Stevenson.
