Fish and Wildlife:

California Department of California Department of Fish and Wildlife Dustin Holyoak, Luis Garcia and Chanelle Davis were in attendance. At least 100 new recruits for Fish and Wildlife are in the hiring process. The current budget has been reduced by 10%. The Drought Funding is no longer available as of 6/30/23. There were no special projects to be reported on. Fish and Wildlife are focusing on fishing with no major incidents. There is an average of 100-120 citations per year, currently only 27 citations were written so far this year. There is a newly funded position to handle wildlife problems. Currently the Deputy D. A. is working with the department and continues to follow up on the filed cases. The progress is continuing to improve and working towards the goal of prosecuting more cases. Many of the citations are getting reduced to misdemeanors. Chanelle Davis discussed the upcoming Family Pheasant Hunt on 11/4/23 at the Camp Cady Wildlife Area. Bear season is active, and they are working to communicate with individuals on how to proceed during this time.
