

TOWN LEGEND

1. **Visitor's Center** - A cooling area with A/C, seating and historical photos and town videos as well as local attraction discount rack cards. Perfect for bus drivers to take a break or those who need a place to stop and rest.
2. **Park Office** - Park, concessionaire and camping information here. Great picture-taking location.
3. **Calico Woodworks** - Metal and wood puzzles and other woodworks handcrafted by local artisans as well as the history of the old west in the 1800s. Offers the Silver King mine tour and 20 Mule Team Off-Road Adventure tour to Borate.
4. **Town Hall**
5. **Lane's General Merchandise** - All items carried in a general store, including crafted sodas, soft drinks, water, ice, packaged food items, RV and camping supplies, and candy. Souvenir items, such as clothing, t-shirts, hats, mugs and bags. Sign up for ghost and historical tours at calicoghosttours.com. Entertainment purposes only: "get hitched" licenses with souvenir rings. Appointments are necessary. Last appointment is at 3:30 p.m. Call (760) 254-3340 to make an appointment.
6. **Calico Photo Studio** - Old-time photos, camera and film supplies.
7. **Print Shop** - Newsprints, custom posters, books, signs, license plates and souvenirs. Hats, mugs and other novelty items available.
8. **Calico Barber Shop & Bathhouse Display**
9. **Calico Jail** - Home of the infamous Calico Gunfighters and Marshal Bismarck Bob.
10. **Calico Rock & Gift Shop** - Minerals, rocks and tumbled stones, such as crystal quartz, calcite and amethyst. Himalayan salt lamps and chakras trees. Silver jewelry as well as turquoise and coral Navajo made silver. Calico Rocks & Fossils. Trilobite, orthoceras, ammonites, fish fossils and mosasaurus skulls. Geode cracking and sliver lace onyx mined in the Calico hills.

16. **Livery Stable Stage** - Area for performance and activities.

18. **Calico Sweets Shoppe** - Fudge made onsite with classic and seasonal flavors. Unique dips and seasonings, bulk candy and crafted sodas. Starbucks drinks made to order. Soft-serve ice cream. ATM location.
19. **Dorsey's Dog House** - Dog bakery, treats and accessories
20. **Mystery Shack** - See natural mysteries as you walk through this amazing adventure (additional charge).
21. **Coffee, Tea & Pottery** - Offering an assortment of coffee, tea and pottery goods. *No prepared coffee or tea is served.*
22. **Gold Panning** - Experience panning for gold and you may walk away with a little (additional charge).
23. **Mining Museum/Zenda**
24. **Lil's Saloon and Beer Garden Patio** - Pizza, wings and hot dogs. Popcorn, giant dill pickles. Beer on tap and bottled, crafted sodas, soft drinks and water. Boysenberry and sarsaparilla floats.
25. **Calico Candle and Bath** - Woven goods, basket fillers, candles, candle holders, handmade soaps, baths salts and lotions.
26. **Calico Bottle House (The Other Side)** - Zombie and ghost souvenirs and collectibles.
27. **Maggie's Mine** - One of Calico's original mines and home of the "Glory Hole" (additional charge).
28. **Calico/Odessa Railroad** - A scenic ride with many points of historical interest (additional charge).



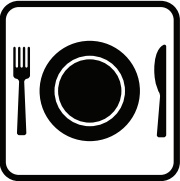

31. **Old Calico Fire Hall**
32. **Calico House Restaurant** - Family-style sit down restaurant known for its fried chicken. Serves breakfast, lunch and dinner. Beer and wine served.
33. **Calico Leather Works and Indian Trading Post** - Scully leather apparel, Minnetonka moccasins, cowboy boots and gun holsters. Native American made beaded bracelets and jewelry, artifacts and gifts.
34. **Silver Bowl Stage** - Area for performances and activities.
35. **Main Street Stage** - Area for performances and activities.
